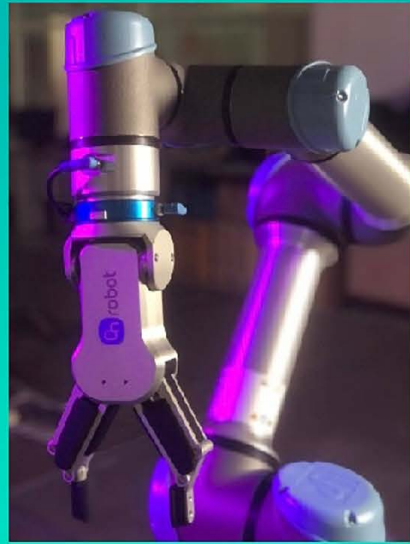

- Proposal for PhD study
- English proficiency qualification as per the following conditions:
 TOEFL: ≥ 550 (PBT), iBT: $\geq 78-79$, IELTS: ≥ 6.0 ,
 TETET: ≥ 5.5 , CEFR: B2 level
